Registration with Upfilter

This season, Skate Canada is using a new competition registration system. All participants must create an account in the new registration system. If you are already registered as participants with the new registration system, you do not need to open a new account for each competition – you simply need to log in your existing account.

Transportation

Skaters must arrive at the airport at least 3 hours prior to the schedule departure time. All flights are scheduled for 8:15am at Pierre-Elliott-Trudeau Airport.

The team leaders will be waiting for the skaters near the Air Canada booth. They will give each skater their boarding pass and will give them instruction to follow. It is very important to follow each step given by the team leaders and to respect the schedule they will give you.

Patinage Québec offers a shuttle service from the Edmonton Airport to the Holiday Inn Express & Suites Edmonton South for skaters travelling with Team Québec and parents of athletes aged 13 and younger who mandatory travel with their child.

Parents of athletes aged 14 and older and coaches will be able to use the shuttle, **only** if there is enough room. Otherwise they will need to take their own transportation to go to the hotel.

Accommodation

Team Québec will be lodging at:

If you don't accompany your child, it is very important that you leave a credit card number with him/her. It is required by the hotel for security deposit, even if two athletes are sharing a room. However, only one credit card number is necessary per room.

2019 Challenge - Communication 1 **Event shuttle for accredited persons**

Transportation between the hotel and the Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre will be provided to for all accredited persons.

The shuttle will be available as of **Tuesday November 27, 2018**.

- The shuttle schedule will be available at Skate Canada info center and at registration.
- Accreditation card must be shown when boarding the shuttle.
- A transportation and information desk will be situated at Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre.

Event shuttle for non-accredited persons

Shuttle passes for parents and chaperones will be available for purchase at a cost \$75 each (cash or credit card), the tickets booth will be situated at the registration desk at the Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre.

Skaters, coaches, chaperones and officials have priority when boarding the shuttle. Other users may be required to wait for the next shuttle in order to give priority for transportation to accredited persons.

Practice session and skating competition events

The practice sessions and the skating competition events will take place at Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre.:

There is a distance of approximately 6.5km between our hotel and the Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre.

A maximum of 2 coaches is authorized by rink side during practices and the competition events.

Skaters accreditation

The accreditation will take place at the Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre, starting Tuesday November 27, 2018.

For your accreditation, you need to submit your music. Don't forget to have your Skate Canada number and a piece of ID with you.

For double entries (skaters competing in two disciplines) music for both discipline must be submitted. The accreditation will be granted only once the music is submitted.

Standards for CDs:

There should be only one (1) program per CD.

The name of the competitor or the team, followed by the category, the program short or free and the length of the music (not the length of the program) must be clearly indicated in print letter on the CD.

Each CD must be presented in its plastic case, marked with the name of the competitor or team, name of the event and the total duration of the music.

Requirements regarding the music

Each skater or team must submit, at registration, two CD for the competition, one (marked "Master") and one extra CD (marked "Copy"). The music will be kept at the Terwillegar Community Recreation Centre and must be picked up by the skaters at the Operations room.
