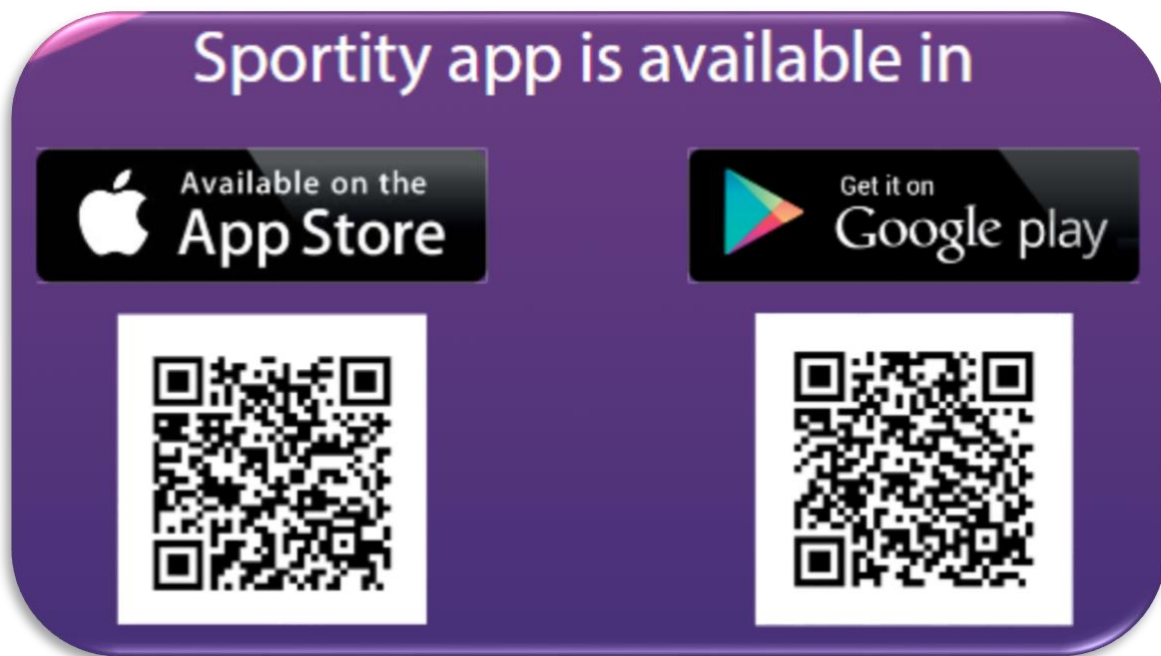

TRANSPORTATION

ARRIVALS

The Organizing Committee will provide transportation from the Toronto International Airport to the Delta Hotels Waterloo starting on Tuesday, February 25, 2025. Transfers to and from the airport will be provided for **officials, event technicians, and streaming only**.

Please look for the Skate Canada volunteer greeters carrying signs once you exit the baggage area.

Should any guest's arrival be delayed for any reason, they are asked to inform the Transportation Desk (**+1.613.914.5348**) as soon as possible with the expected arrival time in Toronto, so that arrangements can be modified.

DEPARTURES

The airport departures at the conclusion of the event will be managed by a departure list with times, which will be sent out by email as well as available at the Transportation Desk at Waterloo Memorial Recreation Complex. Coordinate directly with the Transportation Desk, no later than 24 hours before your pick-up time if you need to change the time of your transportation to the airport.

Music Requirements

All teams must have submitted music online as part of the registration process. Music used at the Event will be the electronic version submitted during registration.



- Competitors must have their back-up file on a USB flash drive– **at the boards during official practice and/or competition.**
- Alternate electronic items such as iPhones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted for playing music.

VICTORY CEREMONIES

The Victory Ceremony schedule and order of medal presentations are indicated on the event schedule.

- Format – 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- All ceremonies will be on ice
- Skaters in full costume with skates on

Team Manager to escort skaters to chute and confirm their arrival. Medals will be presented or available to the skaters, including alternates and skaters without medical clearance, that are registered and included on the team's official registration form for the Skate Canada Cup.

Only those team members in properly tied skates will be allowed on the ice to accept their award. No shoes or crutches will be allowed on the ice surface. Skaters without medical clearance may not wear skates and go on the ice surface.

OFFICIALS' INFORMATION

MEALS AND PER DIEMS

Officials will be provided with a cheque upon registration. The amount you receive will vary based on the number of days you are away from home for the event. Everyone will be provided \$65 per day regardless of travel times.

MEDICAL SERVICES

During practice and competition, rinkside medical personnel will be located at the skaters' entrance to the ice. The Waterloo Memorial Recreation Complex – Medical Room will provide initial injury assessment, first aid and physiotherapy services for acute injuries upon request.
